Audition information

Audition details:

Date: Please arrive at 7.00 pm on Monday 18th February 2019 to register. If you are unable to attend on this date, Tuesday 19th February will be set aside for both auditions and call backs.

Venue: Pymble Players Inc Theatre, Cnr Mona Vale Road and Bromley Avenue Pymble.
Car parking is available.

NOTE: Auditions will be open. There are six characters 4F and 2M (see below), and the relationships between pairs are vitally important, so be prepared to read with one or more other actor/s. To assist in preparation please send an e-mail to the director including your name, age and the character you are interested in. Information regarding specific audition pieces will also be available on request. You may also be asked to “cold read” or improvise.

The play is a great ensemble piece as the roles are equally rated.

Public reading and Audition Preparation:

There will be an open reading of the play starting at 7.00 pm on Tuesday 5th February at the Theatre. Members and non-members are encouraged to participate.

The Peach Season is written by well loved Australian playwright Debra Oswald. It is about “the redemption of damaged souls who have lost their nerve or crave adventure. It combines deadpan humour, emotional truths and gusto told with warmth, humour and understanding a funny and tender play that that is deeply caring of people, irrespective of the mess they create”. *(Extract from Sydney Morning Herald)*.

Actors fulfilling the roles of Celia, Sheena, Zoe and Kieran will need to at least look fit, and strong. The action in many scenes, on the peach farm in summer is “hard work” in sweltering weather!

Synopsis

It's the best season for five years at Celia's farm and the fruit is rotting on the branches for want of pickers. When Kieran and Sheena show up, desperate for work, Celia overcomes her reluctance to have pickers stay on the farm and takes them on, to join her and teenage daughter Zoe. Her fears become reality when the relationship between Zoe and Kieran develops. There are many complications in the plot and the resolutions are very unexpected.

The Peach Season is a powerful, salutary tale showing what it's like to be a young person desperate for independence and the pitfalls of being a parent.

Kieran	Picker. Demanding role; hyper active, ebullient, gauche, noisy, mercurial; can't help liking him.	18
Sheena	Kieran's sister. Tough, sharp tongued, awkward, defensive; does everything to keep Kieran safe	mid 20s
Roza	Hungarian. Eccentric clothes, uses hands, dances, runs packing shed. Great monologues, narrator.	70s
Joe	Roza's son. Solicitor in local town; helpful, kind, conciliatory, has difficult marriage.	40

Rehearsal Information

Venue: Rehearsals will be held Pymble Players Inc Theatre, Cnr Mona Vale Road and Bromley Avenue Pymble. **Anticipated starting date Tuesday 26 February.**

Rehearsals are planned for Tuesdays and Thursdays. Sundays after 2.00 pm will be added, once the set is constructed. All actors appear in most scenes so need to be available for most rehearsals. Selected scenes with pairs only will be held for those characters. Some flexibility is considered, but you will need to indicate any pre-planned commitments on the audition form and with the Director.

A rehearsal schedule will be developed after final casting.
